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# FILL OUT A LINC-IT APPLICATION

After that, you will be connected with a counselor from ASNC or TEACCH®, who will help with the next steps. Those organizations can help fast track the process.

# **AUTISM SPECTRUM DISORDER (ASD)**

One needs an official ASD diagnosis to be a LiNC-IT participant. Vocational Rehabilitation (VR) and TEACCH® can potentially help one get an Autism Spectrum Disorder diagnosis.



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### **VOCATIONAL REHABILITATION**

Call your local <u>Vocational Rehabilitation (VR)</u>, office and indicate your interest in employment through LiNC-IT. To find your local office click <u>here</u>.

# **CONTINUE VR PROCESS**

Your VR counselor will meet with you a few times and determine your eligibility for services. If you are eligible, you and your VR counselor will develop your Individualized Plan for Employment.



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### **CONNECTION TO ASNC OR TEACCH®**

Your Individualized Plan for Employment will likely include a referral to ASNC or TEACCH.

# MEET WITH YOUR JOB COACH

They can help you with your resume, practice interviewing, and identifying potential jobs from employers who are not a part of LiNC-IT. You can meet with your job coach multiple times.



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### **IDENTIFY JOB OPPORTUNITIES**

If a company contacts LiNC-IT about a relevant employment or internship opportunity, your resume may be submitted. You may be invited to interview for the position.
