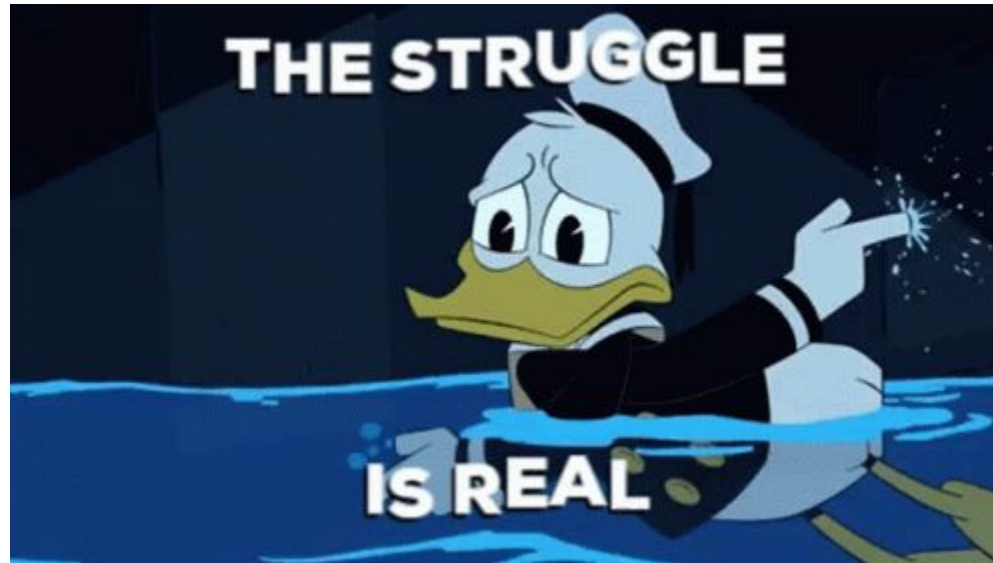

Lessons Learned

- Partnerships with multiple offices and/or departments are essential
 - Personal relationships are VERY important and takes time
 - Don't reinvent the wheel
- The worst someone can say is no or not respond at all
- Don't be afraid to try new things
 - Get comfortable with adjusting or changing programs and events as needed
- Spread events out over time
- Share information through multiple methods and multiple formats
- Network with other professionals through conferences & other events
 - Learn how YOU network best
- Some events need a bit of education/ awareness around them
